Rules and Conditions of Entry

- Competitors should arrive approximately one hour before their expected category start time to avoid missing their event.
- All entrants must register and pay the appropriate fee at least 15 minutes prior to event start.
- Changes to the program may be made on the day if necessary. All competitors will be informed of any changes and the starting time for their event over the PA system on the day.
- All competitors must complete a registration form. For competitors under 18 years of age, a permission form must be signed by a parent or guardian.
- **All competitors must wear appropriate protective gear, and appropriate footwear (shoes with enclosed toes) to be eligible to enter.** Equipment (ie: skateboard) used must be safe and within appropriate sporting standard.
- Competition organizers have the right to refuse entry to competitors on the day who do not comply with competition rules, or for inappropriate behavior or safety reasons.
- Participants must skate within the posted area of the skate event. Any activity conducted outside the posted areas will result in disqualification.

Additional Information

- **All competitors compete at their own risk** - It is advised that competitors wear safety equipment including knee and elbow pads, high ankle protective boots and shin pads.
- **Prizes will be awarded to top scorers in each category.**
- A panel of between two and four experienced judges will judge competitors and the judge's decision is final.
- Competitors will have a warm-up period prior to their event, the length of which will be decided for the event organizer on the day.
- All competitors will be informed of the structure of their competition prior to their event. Skateboard competitors will have a 30 second to one minute runs, depending on their category, followed by either; all competitors having a 30 second or one minute run or a final where a selection of the highest scoring competitors will have a second run. Competitors will only be judged on moves and skills demonstrated which occur in the set competition area during their allocated time.
- Following the beginning of a run, a run will only be declared void (not counted) by the judges in extreme circumstances (conditions to be advised on the day). This will allow for the competitor to have another run.

WAIVER OF LIABILITY/RELEASE OF CLAIMS

A. ACCEPTANCE OF RESPONSIBILITY AND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RISKS:

The undersigned ("Participant") acknowledges that Participant will be participating in a skateboard competition known as the "Ramp'd for Reading Event" ("Activities"). Participant understands and acknowledges the Activities that Participant is to voluntarily engage in bear certain known risks and unanticipated risks which could result in injury, death or damage to myself, to property, or to other third persons. Participant acknowledges that Participant should not enter and skate unless medically able and properly trained, and by Participant's signature below, Participant certifies that Participant is medically able to perform in the Activities, that Participant is in good health, and that Participant is properly trained and experienced to participate in the Activities. Participant agrees to abide by any decision of an event official presiding over the Activities relative to any aspect of Participant's participation or involvement in the Activities, including the right of any official to deny or suspend Participant's participation for any reason whatsoever. Participant assumes all risks associated with participation in the Activities, including conflicts with other participants, spectators, and conditions of the course.

B. RELEASE:

Participant further understands and acknowledges the risks described in Paragraph A, above, could result in claims against the organizers of the Activities, Children's Literacy, Inc. ("CLC"), and/or organizers and/or sponsors of the Activities, and all owners, officers, directors, members, partners, employees, agents, heirs and representatives of the foregoing (collectively, "Personnel"). Participant hereby voluntarily releases Personnel from any and all injuries, claims, demands, actions, rights of actions, liabilities, costs, expenses or damages of any kind or nature whatsoever which are sustained, suffered or incurred by Participant as a result of his/her participation in the Activities as a result of his/her participation therein, including specifically, but not limited to, the negligent acts or omissions of Personnel.

In consideration of Participant's voluntary participation in the Activities, Participant, on behalf of Participant and his/her heirs, executors, distributees, administrators and assigns, hereby releases, waives, discharges and relinquishes Personnel from and against any and all claims, damages, liabilities, injuries, losses, costs, expenses, actions and causes of action which may hereafter arise for or be suffered or incurred by Participant or Participant's estate as a result of Participant's participation in the Activities.

Participant further agrees, promises and covenants not to sue, assert or otherwise maintain any claim against Personnel for any claims, damages, liabilities, injuries, losses, costs, expenses, actions and causes of action to myself or my property arising from or in connection with my participation in the Activities. IN SIGNING THIS DOCUMENT, I FULLY RECOGNIZE THAT IF ANYONE IS HURT OR PROPERTY IS DAMAGED WHILE I ENGAGED IN THIS EVENT, I WILL HAVE NO RIGHT TO MAKE A CLAIM OR FILE A LAWSUIT AGAINST PERSONNEL EVEN IF THEY OR ANY OF THEM NEGLIGENTLY CAUSED THE BODILY INJURY OR PROPERTY DAMAGE.

The undersigned acknowledges that he/she has read the foregoing paragraphs, is over eighteen (18) years of age or otherwise is the parent or legal guardian if the Participant is a minor under the age of eighteen (18), has been informed of the serious risks faced by Participant as a result of Participant's participation in the Activities, and has voluntarily signed this Waiver of Liability/Release of Claims with full knowledge of the legal consequences of doing so. Participant represents and warrants that he/she has no physical limitations, injuries or conditions that would prevent, limit or otherwise affect his/her participation in the Activities.

Participant further understands and agrees that this is the entire Agreement between myself and Personnel and that it cannot be modified or changes in any way by the representations or statements of any employee or agent of Personnel.
